SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT ACCEPTANCE AGREEMENT

A scholarship recipient is an individual who is pursuing post secondary skilled trades education and training at Greater Michigan Construction Academy. Applicants must have completed high school or received a GED within the past 2 years.

The scholarship awarded will cover the cost of tuition and books for a student's first year of a program (two semesters) at GMCA. The scholarship amount will not exceed tuition/book costs and has no cash value to the recipient.

As recipient of a scholarship, I agree to adhere to all GMCA Policies and Procedures. This includes all policies and procedures documented in the Student Handbook and specifically listed items below:

1. Scholarship must be used to attend the GMCA Program for one of the specified trades offered. The offerings available may change based on course interest and feasibility of offering a specific program.
2. I understand failure to adhere to all GMCA Policies and Procedures will result in loss of the scholarship. If scholarship is revoked, individual is not eligible for future scholarships.
3. Progress report information on attendance and grades will be collected on scholarship recipient weekly and reviewed at monthly Scholarship Committee Meetings to ensure student adherence to policies and procedures, attendance requirements, and acceptable grade verification.
